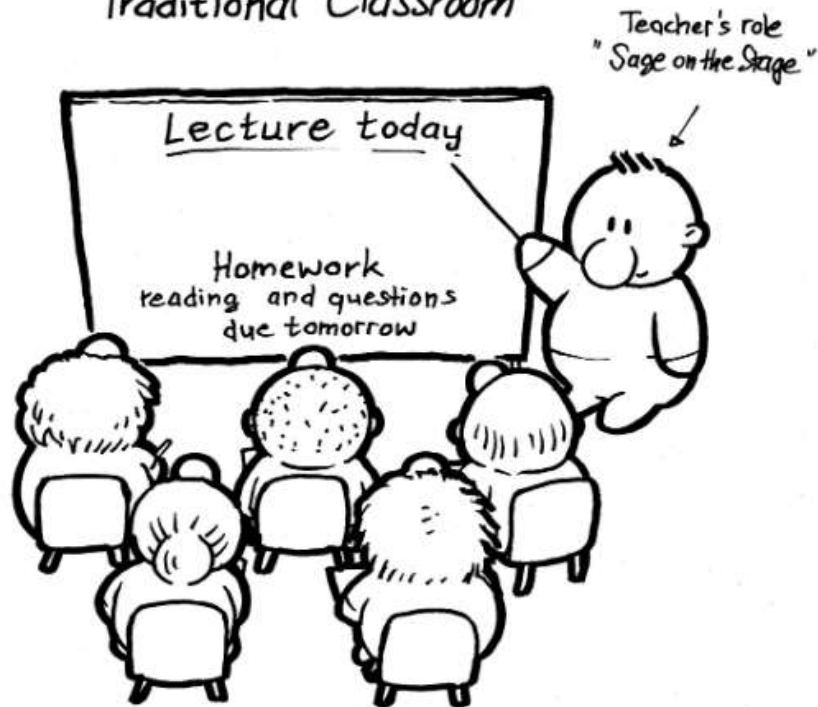

# Benefits of the Inverted Classroom Approach

Self-paced learning



Let students pause, rewind, and rewatch the materials

Active Learning



Let students take charge of the learning situation.

Collaborative learning & Peer instruction



Let students learn from each other

Problem-based learning



Learning by doing

# Implementing the Inverted Classroom Approach

1

## PLAN

Outline the learning objectives and what lesson you want to flip.

2

## RECORD

Record video tutorials to present information.

3

## SHARE

Share the content with your students for them to watch/learn before class.



## **CHANGE**

That they've viewed the materials before class is the change. They're ready to go in-depth now.



## **GROUP**

Put your students in groups and have them complete collaborative tasks.



## **REGROUP**

Bring the group together and have them present and discuss!
